The Board of Supervisors of Pocahontas County, Iowa, met in special session to review budget requests.

Members present: Chairman, Clarence Siepker; Supervisors, Jeffrey Ives, Brent Aden, Louis Stauter and Kyle Smith; and Auditor, Kelly Jepsen.

Starting at 10:00 a.m., the Board met with the following department heads to review their budget request for FY22. Budgets reviewed were Treasurer, Homemakers, Zoning, E911, EMA, Conservation, Auditor, Library, Ambulance, and County Attorney.

Motion by Stauter, seconded by Aden, to keep the Library's budget the same as FY21, a 0% increase. Ayes-Aden, Stauter, Smith; Nay-Siepker, Abstain-Ives. Motion carried.

Motion by Aden, seconded by Stauter, to increase the Ambulance's budget 2% from FY21. Ayes all, motion carried.

Motion by Stauter, seconded by Aden, to decrease the Compensation Board's recommendation by 50% for all elected officials except the Board of Supervisors. Ayes-Aden, Siepker, Stauter, Smith; Nay-Ives, motion carried.

Motion by Stauter, seconded by Aden, to rescind the motion to decrease the Compensation Board's recommendation by 50% for all elected officials except the Board of Supervisors. Ayes all, motion carried.

Motion by Stauter, seconded by Aden, to decrease the Compensation Board's recommendation by 50% for all elected officials. Ayes-Aden, Siepker, Stauter, Smith; Nay-Ives, motion carried.

Motion by Smith, seconded by Ives, to approve the budget review minutes, dated January 11, 2021, as presented. Ayes all, motion carried.

Motion by Ives, seconded by Smith, to acknowledge Anne Thompson's email, requesting an additional \$3,000 for the Nurse's budget and \$400.00 for Environmental Health's budget for utilities.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
