The Board of Supervisors of Pocahontas County, Iowa, met in special session to review budget requests.

Members present: Chairman, Louis Stauter; Supervisors, Jeffrey Ives, Brent Aden, Clarence Siepker, and Kyle Smith; and Auditor, Kelly Jepsen.

At 10:00 a.m. until 2:30 p.m., the Board met with department heads to review their budget requests for FY23. Budgets reviewed were: Conservation, County Attorney, Zoning/E-911/ EMA, Secondary Roads, Auditor, Clerk of Court, Weed Commissioner, Medical Examiner, Library and Ambulance.

The following changes were requested: County Attorney-make adjustments to wages to match the wage study, recalculate FICA, IPERS, health insurance to the correct rates; Zoning-increase mileage by \$100.00; EMA-recalculate salary and benefits and work with Director on grant dollars; Library-change rate to same as last year, Ayes – Stauter, Smith, Aden, Nays - Siepker, Ives abstained; Ambulance-keep \$30,000 for Pocahontas Ambulance only if the City of Pocahontas matches the amount and give a 5% increase to all other ambulance services, Smith abstained.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
