JUNE 2ND PRIMARY ELECTION

In-Person Absentee Voting Begins In South Entry of Pocahontas County Courthouse

POCAHONTAS COUNTY-Pocahontas County Auditor, Kelly Jepsen, has announced that absentee ballots for the June 2nd Primary Election will be available to be voted in-person, starting Monday, May 4, 2020, in the South entrance of the Pocahontas County Courthouse, located at 99 Court Square, Pocahontas County, Iowa. Voters are able to cast their vote from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. Monday-Friday, through Monday, June 1st at 5:00 pm. In addition, the South entry will be open until 5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 22nd, and from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm on Saturday May 30th.
