Motion by Ives, seconded by Stauter, to approve the agenda as posted. Ayes all, motion carried.

MaryJo Litwiller, Economic Development Director, requested to hire Eric Gerdes as a Summer Intern for Economic Development. Gerdes would work from approximately May 28<sup>th</sup> to August 18<sup>th</sup>, 25-30 hours a week at \$12.00 an hour. Jack Moellering, County Engineer, and Tate Schmeling, Asst. County Engineer, discussed equipment they are considering purchasing, a claw bucket for the large excavator and a wheeled excavator. Currently Roads is renting a claw bucket for demolition. All rent paid will be put towards a purchase. They have been testing out different wheeled excavators and have found the safety features on the Caterpillar Excavator to be the best. They will bring quotes to the Board for approval once they decide.

Supervisor Stauter advised that Leroy Nieland would like a hidden driveway sign placed by his residence on N-28. After discussion, it was the consensus of the Board to have Roads place a sign by Nieland's residence.
