The Board of Supervisors of Pocahontas County, Iowa, met for a regular session pursuant to adjournment. Members present: Chairman, Kyle Smith; Supervisors, Jeff Ives, Louis Stauter, Clarence Siepker, Brent Aden; Auditor, Nita Hinrickson. Others present: Reporter, Erin Sommers.

Motion by Clarence Siepker, seconded by Brent Aden, to approve the minutes from August 20, 2024 as presented. Ayes all, motion carried.

Motion by Jeff Ives, seconded by Louis Stauter, to approve the agenda as amended with removal of beavertail claim. Ayes all, motion carried.

Old business: Kyle reported that Kolacia got back to him on the preliminary findings from the historical society grant and they initially said we did not qualify because we do not pay taxes. We do pay livestock and FICA taxes so Kolacia will take that information back and see if we qualify now.

Tate Schmeling, County Engineer, advised the Board he was going to reach out to companies that will do parking lot lines and have them design and paint with himself overseeing and having input. Shouldering should be completed on C49 on Thursday and then lines will be painted. Patching on roads is all complete. Tate will check with crack sealers to see when they will be coming back. Two projects in Sherman Township will start in mid to late October. There will be 2 bridges let in 2025 and 2 more in 2026 along with 3 sections of roadways. Engineering Tech position closed on Sunday. They received 8 applicants and Tate is preparing questions and will start interviewing.

Motion by Brent Aden, seconded by Clarence Siepker, to recess from regular meeting and go into joint drainage meeting with Buena Vista for discussion purposes only.

Louis Stauter wanted to go over the assessment on Jt DD 18-42 due to questions he was receiving. Only 96% was levied in 2018. Due to not levying 100% plus interest that is what the extra 6% levy was approved at a prior meeting.

Upon ending the drainage meeting the board went back into the regular meeting.

Motion by Brent Aden, seconded by Clarence Siepker to approve the hire of Mara Hingson as FT Home Health Aide. Mara will begin full time starting September 4, 2024 at \$20.50 per hour. Ayes all, motion carried.
