The Board of Supervisors of Pocahontas County, Iowa, met in special session to discuss FY22 budgets.

Members present: Chairman, Clarence Siepker; Supervisors, Jeffrey Ives, Brent Aden, Louis Stauter and Kyle Smith; and Auditor, Kelly Jepsen.

Motion by Stauter, seconded by Smith to authorize longevity to Secondary Roads, as it was previously part of their union contract. Ayes all, motion carried. Auditor Jepsen will send a memo out to the department.

Paul Greufe, Human Resource Advisor, presented the wage study to the Board telephonically. The Board had lots of questions and requested that Greufe meet with them in person to review the study. The Board felt that they needed time to absorb the information before they felt comfortable implementing the wage bands. FY22 wages increase will remain at 2%, as approved at the Board meeting on Tuesday, January 19, 2021.
