The Board of Supervisors of Pocahontas County, Iowa, met in regular session pursuant to adjournment.

Members present: Chairman, Jeffrey Ives; Supervisors, Clarence Siepker, Brent Aden, Louis Stauter, and Ed Dewey; Deputy Auditor, Kalista Herr; and Reporter, Erin Sommers. Electronically: Auditor, Kelly Jepsen; and Supervisor Ed Dewey.

Motion by Stauter, seconded by Aden, to approve the minutes, dated October 27, 2020, as presented. Ayes all, motion carried.

Motion by Stauter, seconded by Dewey, to approve the tentative agenda with the addition of canceling next week's Board meeting. Ayes all, motion carried.

Gary Atherton, Assistant to the Engineer/Drainage Clerk, and the Board discussed two Jt. DD 181 claims and the cost to landowner for private tile extensions needing repair found during district repairs. Motion was made by Aden, seconded by Stauter, to approve the Jt. DD 181 Big Cedar Tile claim from Pocahontas County Secondary Roads in the NW Quarter of Section 1, Cedar Township, for repairs, for \$1,395.78 and instruct the Auditor to bill Matt Koster \$300.00 for the installation of 20 foot of tile extension. Ayes-Aden, Stauter, Nays-Ives, Siepker, Abstain-Dewey. Motion fails. Motion by Stauter, seconded by Siepker, to table the following two claims: Jt. DD 181 Little Cedar Tile claim from Pocahontas County Secondary Roads in the NW Quarter of Section 29, Dover Township, for repairs, for \$14,911.32; and Jt. DD 181 Big Cedar Tile claim from Pocahontas County Secondary Roads in the NW Quarter of Section 1, Cedar Township, for repairs, for \$1,395.78. Ayes all, motion carried.

Anne Thompson, Public Health Director, advised of the number of cases of COVID in Pocahontas County and stated that the State numbers have tripled. With COVID concerns at the Courthouse, motion was made by Stauter, seconded by Aden, to close down the County Annex and Courthouse, with the exception of Secondary Roads and Sheriff's Department, until next Monday, the custodians will thoroughly clean and disinfect at the Annex and Courthouse, and then open up by appointment only until COVID cases slow down again. Ayes all, motion carried.

After Atherton and the Board discussed the DD 59 repair project, a motion was made by Stauter, seconded Aden, to hire Anderson Drainage to do the Open Ditch excavation, the spoil bank leveling, the disking of the rock and seeding. The pipe replacement will be out for bids with the County supplying the pipe. Ayes all, motion carried.

The Board discussed the retirement of Recorder, Mike Bollard, and their options to appoint vs calling for a special election. Motion by Siepker, seconded by Stauter, to File a notice of intent to appoint, form a committee to take applications with the goal of appointing a new County Recorder at the first business meeting in 2021. Ayes all, motion carried.

Weekly meetings: Siepker-Upper Des Moines, CSS, two Rolling Hills meetings, DD 175 concerns, Workforce Development meeting, and Laurens Police concerns; Aden-Gilmore City stop sign concerns and DD 47 concerns; Ives-Solid Waste; Stauter-N-28 concerns, and Jt. DD 181 intake and surface tube concerns; and Dewey- COVID Concerns.

Motion by Stauter, seconded by Siepker, to cancel Tuesday, November 17, 2020 Board meeting, due to COVID concerns. Ayes all, motion carried.
