Demonstrations on the two different control access and camera systems were performed on Tuesday. Tate has been talking with the Railroad regarding fixing the road by Plover preliminary cost would be \$12,000.00 for an engineer to look and see how to fix the road between the tracks. Then can determine the cost to fix. Tate is also looking at the budget and getting quotes on new equipment.
