The Board of Supervisors of Pocahontas County, Iowa, met in special session to discuss FY22 budgets.

Members present: Chairman, Clarence Siepker; Supervisors, Jeffrey Ives, Brent Aden, Louis Stauter and Kyle Smith; and Auditor, Kelly Jepsen.

Motion by Aden, seconded by Stauter, to add an additional \$10,000.00 to the Mental Health levy to ensure cash flow for operating expenses until property taxes are collected. Ayes all, motion carried.

Motion by Ives, seconded by Smith, to tentatively approve the following levies per \$1,000 of taxable valuations: General Basic, \$3.50000; Pioneer Cemetery, \$0.00575; General Supplemental, \$1.70951; Mental Health, \$0.29697; and Rural Basic, \$3.19569. Ayes all, motion carried.

Motion by Smith, seconded by Stauter, to set the County Attorney's FY22 budget at a 0% increase from FY21. Ayes all, motion carried.

After discussing each department's individual budget request, the Board requested that Auditor Jepsen schedule a meeting between the following Department Administrators/Elected Officials with them to discuss their FY22 budget requests in more detail: County Engineer, Jack Moellering; Sheriff, Steve Nelson; and Conservation Director, Brian Reis.

The Board also gave consideration to Economic Development's budget request and decided to leave the County's contribution the same as FY21.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
