Cole Anderson with Anderson Drainage & Excavating, LLC, met with the Board to discuss a change order request for Jt. DD 63. Anderson requested an additional \$59,825.00 for the extra work on the South part of ditch excavation work, that was added after the contract was signed and \$26,500 for additional cleaning up, moving clay and compacting bank, moving trees and removal of 4 beaver dams on the North side of the ditch. Jon Rosengren, Engineer from Bolton & Menk, participated in the discussion telephonically. Motion by Stauter, seconded by Ives, to approve the change order for a total of \$65,664.10: \$50,864.10 for the additional work on the South part of the ditch and \$14,800 for additional work on the North part of the ditch. Ayes all, motion carried. The \$12,000 for moving the clay across the ditch and compacting the bank will be discussed at a later date.

Motion by Stauter, seconded by Ives, to approve the bid from Bauer Construction for countertop installation for \$11,477.00. Ayes all, motion carried. The other bid is on file in the Auditor's Office. Countertops will be installed in the following offices: Assessor, Clerk of Court, Recorder, and Magistrate.

Bids for truck #122: The City of Pocahontas bid \$25,000.00; and Steve Thayer, from Marathon, IA bid \$18,579.29. Truck #123: City of Pocahontas bid \$25,000.00. Motion by Stauter, seconded by Smith, to accept the bids from the City of Pocahontas for both trucks, totally \$50,000.00. Ayes all, motion carried

Next the Board held a bid letting for concrete patching for 86 separate spots. Two bids were received: Ten Point Construction from Denison, IA for \$322,820.00; and Cedar Falls Construction from Cedar Falls, IA bid \$380,878.00. Motion by Stauter, seconded by Smith, to award Ten Point Construction the contract for concrete patching. Ayes all, motion carried.

Motion by Stauter, seconded by Siepker, to acknowledge Equipment Operator, Jeremiah Smith's last day of employment as Wednesday, April 26, 2023 and wish him well. Ayes-Ives, Stauter, Aden, Siepker; Nays-none; Abstain-Smith; Motion carried.

Motion by Stauter, seconded by Siepker, to authorize the Chairman to sign two purchase agreements for the County Line Bridge project. Ayes all, motion carried. This agreement between Calhoun County and Richard & Marilyn Oberhelman for temporary easement was revised from last week and a new contract between Pocahontas County and Ron W. Hanson Revocable Trust and Sharon K. Hanson Revocable Trust for permanent easement.

Motion by Stauter, seconded by Smith, to authorize the Chairman to sign the Federal Aid Agreement for a City Highway Program Project for the City of Fonda. Ayes all, motion carried.

Jack Moellering, County Engineer, advised that an amendment to the County's five year program was needed so the overlay project on the South 7 miles on N-65 could be moved up a year and to adjust the estimated cost of said project. Motion by Stauter, seconded by Siepker, to amend the five year DOT program. Ayes all, motion carried.

Moellering and the Board discussed getting rid of the dirt stock pile in Laurens, Fonda, and Rolfe and moving the fuel letting to the end of May.

Weekly meetings: Stauter-CFR, all employee meeting, and tile & bridge concerns; Aden-all employee meeting; and Siepker-DCAT and all employee meeting.
