September 26, 2023

The Board of Supervisors of Pocahontas County, Iowa, met for a regular meeting. Members present: Chairman, Brent Aden; Supervisors, Louis Stauter, Jeff Ives, Clarence Siepker, Kyle Smith; and Auditor, Kelly Jepsen. Others present: Reporter, Erin Sommers.

Motion by Siepker, seconded by Smith, to approve the minutes from September 19, 2023 as presented. Ayes all, motion carried.

The agenda was approved as posted on motion by Ives, seconded by Stauter. Ayes all, motion carried.

Jack Moellering, County Engineer, and the Board discussed the next bridge projects and resumes from Iowa State Engineering students. They determined the next bridges to be designed will be Bridge 136, located in Sections 5 and 6 of Garfield Township, and Bridge 21, located in Section 34 of Cedar Township. Moellering will contact three of the Engineering students for possible job opportunities.

Motion by Siepker, seconded by Stauter, to acknowledge the resignation of Keith Hoffman, VA Commissioner and thank him for his many years of service to the Veterans of Pocahontas County. Ayes all, motion carried. Auditor Jepsen will advertise for the vacancy in the County's official newspapers.

Pursuant to Iowa Code section 427.1(22), a motion was made by Stauter, seconded by Ives, to approve the 2023 wetland applications (Natural Conservation and Wildlife Acres property tax exemption). Ayes all, motion carried.

Jepsen and the Board discussed possible changes to the Bereavement and Sick Policy. After discussion of an employee's circumstance, the Board decided not make any change but will revisit the topic later this year.
