**4/14/2021**

**Moderna:**

Prime (1<sup>st</sup>) doses administered: 1480 (1600 received plus another 100 allocated 4/14)  
Boost (2<sup>nd</sup>) doses administered: 1200 (1300 received plus another 100 allocated 4/12)

**Johnson & Johnson:**

200 doses allocated on 3/31 to use at Bobalee, Inc. and for special or at-risk populations  
30 doses used at Bobalee on April 9<sup>th</sup>

### **UPCOMING VACCINATION SCHEDULE – (CLINICS ARE BY APPOINTMENT ONLY!)**

**April 16<sup>th</sup>**

100 2<sup>nd</sup> doses from 3/19 10 – noon in the Assembly Room  
200 1<sup>st</sup> doses from 2 – 5pm in the Assembly Room (100 Moderna & 100 J&J)

**April 23<sup>rd</sup>**

100 2<sup>nd</sup> doses from 3/26 10 – noon at the Expo Center plus Pengo and HorseTech  
100 1<sup>st</sup> doses from 2 – 5pm at the Expo Center

**April 26<sup>th</sup>** – Fisher Hydraulics 2<sup>nd</sup> doses

**April 28<sup>th</sup>** – Positech and BrandFX 2<sup>nd</sup> doses

**May 7<sup>th</sup>** - 100 2<sup>nd</sup> doses at Bobalee, Jack Links, Laurens City Hall and office from 2-4pm

**May 14<sup>th</sup>** - 100 2<sup>nd</sup> doses from 4/16 10am – noon in the Assembly Room

**May 21<sup>st</sup>** – 100 2<sup>nd</sup> doses from 4/23 10am – noon in the Assembly Room

On April 13<sup>th</sup>, IDPH announced that the CDC was recommending a pause in using the Johnson & Johnson vaccine. The ACIP is meeting in the afternoon on April 14<sup>th</sup> and we will decide in the morning on Thursday, April 15<sup>th</sup> what happens to the 100 doses of J&J we have scheduled for Friday, April 16<sup>th</sup> based on the recommendations from that meeting.

We are taking names and scheduling appointments for any individual that is 18 years of age and other that would like to receive the vaccine. Our final large vaccination clinic for prime (1<sup>st</sup> doses) will be April 23<sup>rd</sup>. If there continues to be demand for the vaccine, we will schedule in groups of 10 for the Moderna vaccine at our office. The Moderna vaccine is a 10-dose vial that must be used within six hours after its punctured.
