## **COVID-19 Update/Response**

As of 5/18/2021, there has been 899 cases of COVID-19 reported in Pocahontas County residents. That is up 23 from 4/13/2021.

The COVID-19 response is ongoing. Response efforts have included education, information sharing with staff, community, local residents, businesses, collaboration with local health partners and schools and others regarding latest guidance, isolation and quarantine recommendations.

IDPH continues to provide weekly webinars on several COVID-19 topics and updates. The first COVID-19 vaccine doses arrived on December 21<sup>st</sup>.

### **Moderna: (20 doses remaining)**

Prime (1<sup>st</sup>) doses administered: 1680 (1700 received)

Boost (2<sup>nd</sup>) doses administered: 1600 (1700 received)

### **Johnson & Johnson:**

200 doses allocated on 3/31 to use at Bobalee, Inc. and for special or at-risk populations

30 doses used at Bobalee on April 9<sup>th</sup>

10 doses used at our office on May 13<sup>th</sup>
