City/School Election Absentee Voting Begins at Pocahontas County Auditor's Office

Pocahontas County Auditor and Commissioner of Elections, Kelly Jepsen has announced that absentee ballots for the November 2, 2021, City/School Election are available in the Auditor's Office starting Wednesday, October 13, 2021.

Absentee ballots may be cast in the Pocahontas County Auditor's Office, 99 Court Sq., Suite 7 Pocahontas, IA, during regular office hours from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, through November 1, 2021. Absentee ballots are available for all cities and school districts within the Pocahontas County boundaries.

Absentee ballots must be requested in writing. Request forms are available at the Auditor's Office, on the Pocahontas County website at pocahontas-county.gov or at the Iowa Secretary of State's website, www.sos.iowa.gov.

All requests for ballots to be mailed must be received in the Auditor's Office by 5:00 p.m., October 18, 2021. This is sooner than it has been in the past. Due to recent legislation, requests for a mailed ballot must be received 15 days before the election (formerly 11 days).

Ballots requested through the mail must be received in the Auditor's Office by 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.
