Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered, such as voters registering to vote on Election Day and voters changing precincts, must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required) may: 1.) have voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct. Attesters for voters unable to provide proper identification at the polls must themselves provide proper identification before signing the attester's oath. 2.) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3.) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the County Auditor's office by NOON on Monday, November 8, 2021. Absentee ballots are available for in-person absentee voting in the County Auditor's office during regular business hours, 8:00 a.m. till 4:00 p.m., Monday – Friday, until 4:00 p.m. on Monday, November 1, 2021.
