

Pocahontas County American Rescue Plan Act Project and Program Proposals External Community Organizations

The Pocahontas County Board of Supervisors is inviting community organizations and external partners to submit American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) proposals for funding consideration.

Proposals that will be considered for ARPA funds shall address a public need that has been created or exaggerated by the COVID-19 pandemic and meets the usage and timing requirements of the ARPA legislation.

All applications received by July 1, 2022 will be considered. If your proposal is selected to move forward, a more detailed application will be provided to you. The detailed application will be used to determine funding recipients.

ELIGIBLE EXPENSES FOR PROJECT FUNDING THAT WILL BE CONSIDERED

- 1. Support the public health response** - meet and address emergent public health needs, including through measures to counter the spread of COVID-19, through the provision of care for those impacted by the virus, and through programs or services that address disparities in public health that have been exacerbated by the pandemic.
- 2. Address negative economic impacts caused by the public health emergency** - respond to the public health emergency or its negative economic impacts, including assistance to households, small businesses, and nonprofits, or aid to impacted industries such as tourism, travel, and hospitality.
- 3. Replace lost public sector revenue** - for the provision of government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue experienced due to the COVID-19 public health emergency.
- 4. Invest in water, sewer, and broadband infrastructure** – allows for a broad range of necessary investments in projects that improve access to clean drinking water, improve wastewater and stormwater infrastructure systems, and to make necessary investments in broadband infrastructure.
