- Full sun
- Zone 2-7
- · Height: 50-60 feet
- Spread: 15 feet
- Medium growth rate; slower in summer
- Prefers moist sandy loam soils
- Drought tolerant

Wildlife value: Provides
nesting sites for birds and
shelter for many kinds of
wildlife. Crossbills, evening
grosbeaks and red-breasted
nuthatches eat the seeds,
and grouse, rabbits, and deer
eat the foliage. Red squirrels
cut open cones to eat the
seeds, and they feast upon
young, tender spruce shoots.
